DESCRIPTION:

*Provide assistance to the Adventure Club Manager, Staff and Faculty Advisor, and help facilitate the Club.

ADVENTURE CLUB OVERVIEW:

Adventure Clubs support our mission by serving approximately 15-20 high school students per club in underserved communities year round. The clubs meet weekly after school and attend one Core Adventure Trip each month. Weekly meeting and monthly trips are planned, organized, and run by the Adventure Club Manager and involve trip preparation, enrichment activities like yoga or disc golf, hikes, indoor climbing, etc.

LENGTH OF COMMITMENT:

one club meeting per week (weekdays), one trip per month (weekend): September thru June.

NUMBER OF VOLUTNEERS NEEDED:

One volunteer per Adventure Club, we currently have three Adventure Clubs at Lincoln High School, El Cajon Valley High School and Crawford High School.

DUTIES:

- * Attend and help facilitate the weekly club meeting
- * Assist on monthly trips
- * Assist AC staff in engaging student participants
- * Attend a review session with staff (every other month)
- * Connect with youth
- * Be a role model for youth

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- * Flexible schedule (weekly weekday meetings regularly held from 2:30-4:30pm)
- * Dynamic and outgoing personality
- * Experience with teen youth
- * CPR and First Aid certification, a plus
- * Ability to pass a Live Scan background check (at your own expense ~\$15-20)
